REPORTS AND UNFINISHED

	<p>Mayor Lobinsky stated that a meeting was held on January 28th to close out the loan portion of the Well #3 project and move on to the grant portion of the project. The project is more than 50% completed. The Village is looking at an April opening of Well #3. Mayor Lobinsky also stated that the portion of the loan taken over by the USDA was locked in at a rate of 2.25%.</p> <p>Mayor Lobinsky spoke on an incident that happened on the 19th. Cold weather conditions and a heater failure caused some damage to pipes and the chlorinator at Well #2. This did cause several thousands of dollars in damage and is being submitted to insurance for reimbursement.</p> <p>Mayor Lobinsky stated he would like to have a discussion with the Board regarding Trustee salaries. With the upcoming election next year, he would like to see those salaries increased to hopefully see some more participation from the community and make the position more attractive when that time comes. Attorney Green said he could provide some numbers from other communities he represents.</p> <p>Mayor Lobinsky wanted to remind residents to please not push snow into the streets during snowfall. Trustee Wohlfarth asked about parking during snowfall which Mayor Lobinsky addressed.</p> <p>Mayor Lobinsky gave a report on the Village emergency phone line. Mayor Lobinsky stated 8 calls were received 1, which was a resident and the rest being alarms.</p>
