	<p>Mayor Lobinsjy presented to the Board for approval Ordinance 20-3, an Ordinance Pertaining to Local State of Emergency. Mayor Lobinsky stated the contents of this Ordinance was modeled after a draft prepared by the Illinois Municipal League. Attorney Green gave a description of how and why this Ordinance was developed and how it works. Mayor Lobinsky stated this Ordinance is only in place during a local state of emergency. Mayor Lobinsky stated a few minor wordings will need to be addressed before this Ordinance is completed. Discussion on several items in this Ordinance were discussed in length amongst the Board with Attorney Green giving some insight to these items.
